# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Collection of Large Unwanted Household items

Council intends to conduct a kerbside collection of large unwanted household items on **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019** in Bedourie and Birdsville. This is your chance to clean up your yard and dispose of items that you may not be able to take to the tip yourself due to their size.

Residents are to ensure that any items for collection are on the footpath outside their house by the Tuesday afternoon prior. Rubbish should be kept in a neat pile so as not to be a hazard to pedestrians.

Council won't pick up:

- general household waste (e.g. food scraps)
- glass and mirrors
- hazardous wastes (e.g. chemicals, oil, asbestos)
- household waste that normally goes into your wheelie bin
- liquids

If you have large items within your yard which you cannot move onto the footpath, eg car body or tanks, please contact the Town Foreman to arrange collection. Council staff will enter your yard only if you are home at the time. While all care will be taken in the removal of the rubbish, Council will not be responsible for damage sustained inside the property from the removal of the rubbish, eg to lawns

Council will also assist commercial premises to remove bulky items from their premises. This service will be provided on a cost recovery basis. Businesses are asked to contact Trevor Stewart, Infrastructure Manager if they would like to take up this offer.

This is a great opportunity to clean up the town prior to the tourist season so that we present a clean image to our visitors. With the flooding that has and will occur close to the towns it is likely that in the coming weeks/months mice, rats, feral cats and snakes will be looking for places to hide and breed. Removing the accumulation of rubbish from your premises now, will help minimise the number of these pests.
