Bedourie Community Gym

Council is pleased to advise that the Gym in Bedourie is now open. To encourage maximum utilisation, it will be open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

There will be three types of membership available:

1. Restricted – for applicants over 12 years of age but under 16 years. The applicant will not receive an access card and must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian who is a member. The Parent or Guardian must sign the Acknowledgement section of the membership form on behalf of the applicant.
2. Conditional – for applicants over 16 years but under 18 years. The applicant will receive an access card but the Parent or Guardian must give signed permission on the membership form for the applicant to attend the gym unsupervised.
3. Full – for applicants over 18 years. The applicant will receive an access card.

The membership fee is \$25 for six months. To become a member please visit the Bedourie Visitor Information Centre and complete a Gym Membership form. If you already have a pool access card, please bring it along and we will reprogram it to include Gym access.

For your own safety, it is important that you read, understand and follow the Conditions of Entry and Conditions of Use available on the membership form.

The gym and the fitness services provided at the gym are NOT supervised at ANY time. There are no staff on site to instruct in the use of equipment or to administer emergency care, including CPR if needed or to call emergency services. The use of this gym and the gym equipment is at your sole risk and liability.

A closed circuit television system (CCTV) operates within the gym being used for the purposes of public safety and crime prevention and detection.
