Background

Arts Queensland is proud to partner with local government to support quality arts and cultural experiences across Queensland through the Regional Arts Development Fund (RADF). RADF promotes the role and value of arts, culture and heritage as key drivers of diverse and inclusive communities and strong regions. RADF invests in local arts and cultural priorities, as determined by local communities, across Queensland.

RADF supports the role and value of Arts, Culture and Heritage as key drivers to: support diversity and inclusivity, grow strong regions; and provide training, education and employment opportunities for Queensland Artists and local communities.

Eligibility

This funding is available to local community organisations within Diamantina Shire for events and activities which aim to provide opportunities for community participation in arts and cultural activities based on locally determined priorities.

Funding Criteria

Events or projects need to:

Support local artists and arts and cultural activity to deliver value for local communities

Provide opportunities for local communities to participate in arts and cultural activities

Invest in locally-determined priorities (through arts and cultural activity) including;

- Building local capacity and sustainability in the areas of small arts / cultural businesses and initiatives;
- Encouraging and supporting cultural tourism projects and initiatives;
- Encouraging regional and local cooperation, resource sharing and partnerships;
- Support for projects and activities which promote a motivated and involved community.

Examples of eligible projects

Community Events, activities and/or functions such as music concerts, food festivals, art workshops, or exhibitions.

Establishment or re-establishment of ongoing community support groups to build community connectedness and resilience.

Neighborhood and community workshops on issues such as psychological wellbeing, planning for the future.

Events & resources aimed at engaging and retaining volunteers or supporting the capacity of community leaders to provide information, advice and referrals.

Acknowledgment of funding

The Applicant must:

- ensure that, in any promotional material and publications about a Project/Activity, including newspapers, websites, display signage and banners, and on products created (where relevant), they acknowledge the financial assistance provided by the Queensland Government under the RADF Program; and
- use the words 'The Regional Arts Development Fund is a partnership between the Queensland Government and [insert Council name] Council to support local arts and culture in regional Queensland'.

The acknowledgement must:

- prominently show the Queensland Government crest available for download at <http://www.arts.qld.gov.au/aq-funding/acknowledgement>; and
- be no smaller in size and of no less visual significance than any other acknowledgement of assistance received for the Project/Activity, unless the prior written consent of Arts Queensland is obtained. In cases where Arts Queensland is the major contributor of funds, the acknowledgement should be separate from and precede all other acknowledgements.
