Locations for Automated External Defibrillators (A.E.D's)

To further improve effective response in a medical emergency situation, Council, with the aid of a grant, has installed two Automated External Defibrillators (AED's) within Bedourie town.

One AED has been installed inside the Bedourie Community Hall and the other one has been installed outside of the Bedourie Gym, these AED's are only to be used in a medical emergency. The AED's are very easy to use and once the AED is opened, voice guidance will step the operator through all necessary requirements.

These AED's have been installed inside an alarmed cabinet, when the cabinet is opened to extract the AED an alarm will sound and a strobe light will also be activated, the purpose of the alarm and strobe light is to assist in alerting nearby persons to an emergency situation.

In addition, AED's are located in the following:

- Outside Main Entrance to the Wirrari Centre, Birdsville
- Outside the Caravan Park Office, Birdsville
- Simpson Desert Oasis, Bedourie
- All Council Work Camps
